Roser Dolz is Doctor in Veterinary Medicine by the Autonomus University of Barcelona (UAB) since 2001. She carried out her PhD project in Centre de Recerca en Sanitat Animal (CRESA) and awarded a PhD in the UAB in 2007. During her pre-doctoral training she made a research stay at Poultry Diagnostic and Research Center at the University of Georgia. In 2014 she was named European Diplomat for Poultry by the European College of Poultry Science (ECPVS). From 2007 to 2014 she worked as a researcher in Centre de Recerca en Sanitat Animal (CRESA). Her research was mainly focused on avian viral diseases and Campylobacter infection in poultry. In 2014 she joined as General Manager the company PH Iberica, focused on development and comercialization of animal feed additives. After two years, she joined MSD Animal Health Spanish Team where she is currently working as Poultry Technical Specialist. She has broad experience in diagnosis of avian diseases, molecular epidemiology of avian viral diseases (IBV, IBDV, adenovirus, ILT), development of experimental infection models and pathogenesis studies, and design of field and experimental trials in poultry. She has published more than 20 international papers (JRC), 10 national papers and 2 books. In addition, she has participated as lecturer in numerous national and international poultry meetings, courses, and seminars.
